Registration

We welcome anyone desiring to begin or continue music instruction. Adults and children may enroll and will receive appropriate instruction adapted to their age and experience. To register please contact the SSOFA Director, Joy Bryan at joyubryan@yahoo.com, 770-972-5401 (home), or 678-773-4895 (cell) or complete the attached registration form.

A \$35 fee per SSOFA year payable to Sunrise Baptist Church is due at registration. A \$10 re-enrollment fee for returning students is due for each semester per SSOFA year. These fees cover administrative expenses.

Tuition

Semester 2 tuition is \$20 per lesson for 13 lessons to be paid for the entire semester (\$260) in two payments. The first payment of \$140 is due at the first lesson. The second payment of \$120 is due at the fifth lesson. You may also choose to pay the entire \$260 at the first lesson. Tuition is paid directly to the instructor.

Instruments

Students provide their own instrument. Sunrise will not lend or rent instruments. We will have information about places to inquire about renting and/or buying instruments.

Incident Weather Policy

We follow the Gwinnett County School schedule. If schools are closed for inclement weather we will NOT have lessons that day. The missed lesson will be added to the end of the semester or rescheduled by the instructor. If the weather worsens during the day and lessons are canceled the instructor will make every effort to contact you.

Missed Lesson Policy

Students must give notice to their instructor at least 24 hours in advance when missing a scheduled lesson. One make-up lesson will be awarded each student. If the student is late for a lesson the instructor is under no obligation to extend the lesson beyond the normal ending time or reschedule the lost time. If the instructor is late the lesson will either be extended or the lost time will be rescheduled.

Expectation of Student Practice

Regular practice is essential. It is recommended that students practice daily the same amount of time as their lesson.
